Genesis 37:3-4—Now Israel [Jacob] loved Joseph more than any of his other sons, because he had been born to him in his old age; and he made an ornate robe for him. When his brothers saw that their father loved him more than any of them, they hated him and could not speak a kind word to him.

Romans 8:28—And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Them, who have been called according to Their purpose.

Genesis 39:2—The Lord was with Joseph, and he became a successful man; he was in the house of his Egyptian master.

Genesis 39:6b-7—Now Joseph was handsome and good-looking. And after a time his master's wife cast her eyes on Joseph and said, "Lie with me."

Genesis 39:21—But the Lord was with Joseph and showed him steadfast love; he gave him favor in the sight of the chief jailer.
