Evangelical	Renewalist

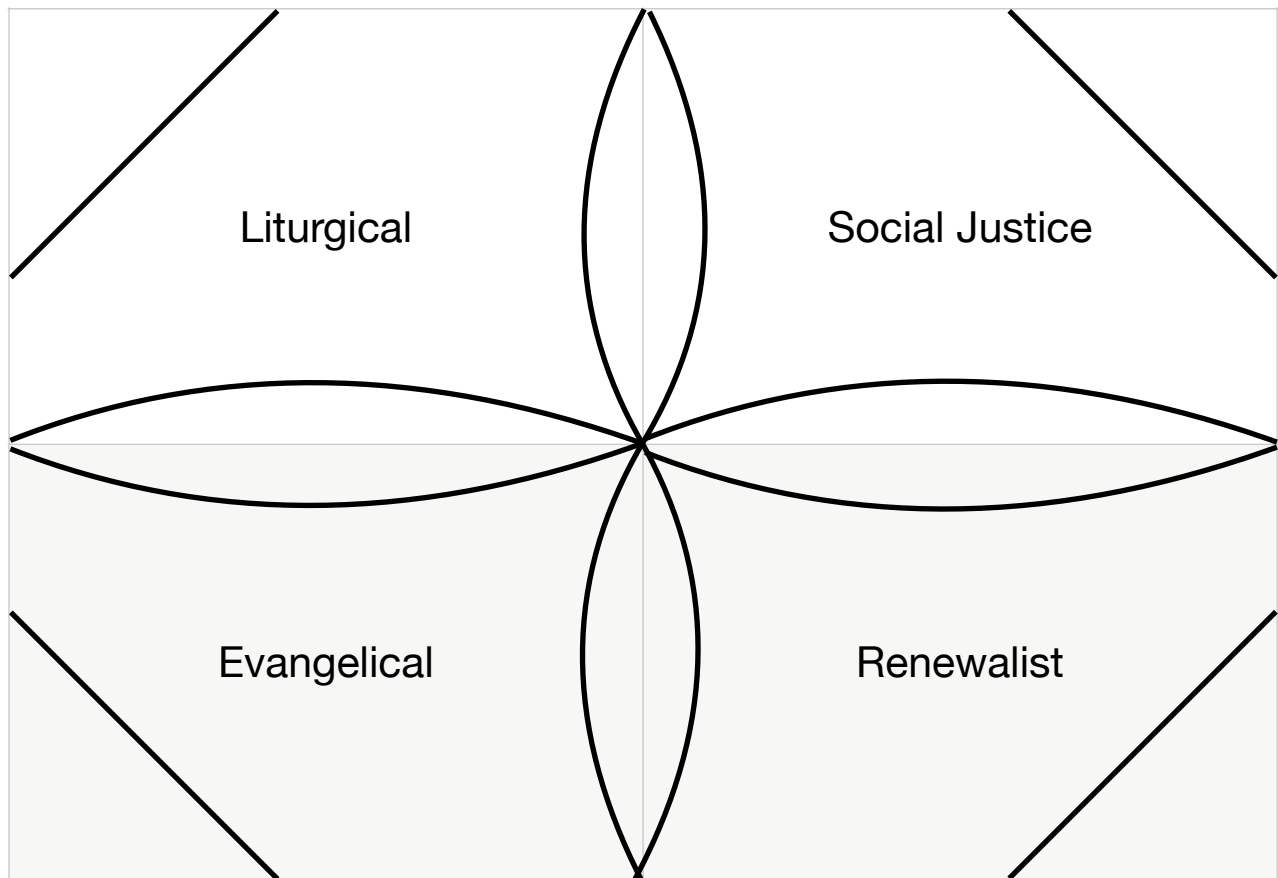
The *liturgical* quadrant represents those church communions for whom the proper and faith-filled celebration of the liturgy is of central importance.

The *social justice* quadrant includes churches that preach what used to be called the “social gospel” for its emphasis on social justice; central is concern to redress injustices like racism, sexism and poverty.

The *evangelical* quadrant represents those for whom the Bible, the “born again” conversion experience, and the preaching of the gospel are central identifiers.

The *renewalist* quadrant is marked by a renewed interest in experience.
